COLUMBARIUM AND GARDEN OF HOPE UPDATE

The Session approved the first major update to our 10-year-old Columbarium Policies & Regulations which have served us very well since the construction of our Columbarium in 2007. This update was necessary to reflect current views on management of interments in our Columbarium and Garden of Hope.

These new Policies & Regulations take effect immediately except for the cost of a regular niche reservation which will go to \$2,000 on September 1, 2018. Our current pricing of \$1,500 will be honored until this date. Garden of Hope interments will rise to \$300. New Columbarium brochures are now available in the Narthex or church office.
