Patty has served as rehearsal accompanist, organist, and harpsichordist for many years for the Messiah Association of Winter Haven and the Bach Festival of Central Florida. She served on the accompanying staff at Florida Southern College for 10 years, performing in recital with students and faculty. Having served as interim organist at United Methodist Church of Honolulu, First Presbyterian Churches of Lake Wales and Winter Haven, she now serves as organist at Beymer Memorial United Methodist Church of Winter Haven. She has appeared as harpsichordist with the Chamber Orchestra of Florida, the Great Neck Choral Society and Orchestra of New York City, Voices of the People at Polk State College, the Symphony Guild of Winter Haven “Wine and Roses,” and the City of Winter Haven Symphonia “Champagne and Shamrocks.”

Philip King is an active bass-baritone, pianist, and composer. He studied voice and piano performance at Drake University where his principal teachers were Bruce Perry, Edward Corpus, and Nicholas Roth. Philip has appeared on stage and served as music director for dozens of musical theatre productions. His most recent work includes The Hunchback of Notre Dame (TWH), Big Fish (TWH), Shrek (Ocala Civic Theatre), Peter and the Starcatcher (TWH), Million Dollar Quartet (TWH), and Beauty and the Beast (TWH). In addition to theatrical work, Mr. King has appeared in concert with the Orlando Philharmonic, Gloria Musicae, Encore! Cast Performing Arts, the Fort Dodge Choral Society, and the Des Moines Metro Opera. He currently serves as the Associate Director of Music at Hope Presbyterian Church in Winter Haven, where he also maintains a private teaching studio. This year, he is also proud to serve as the conductor of the inaugural season of the Winter Haven Community Singers.
